



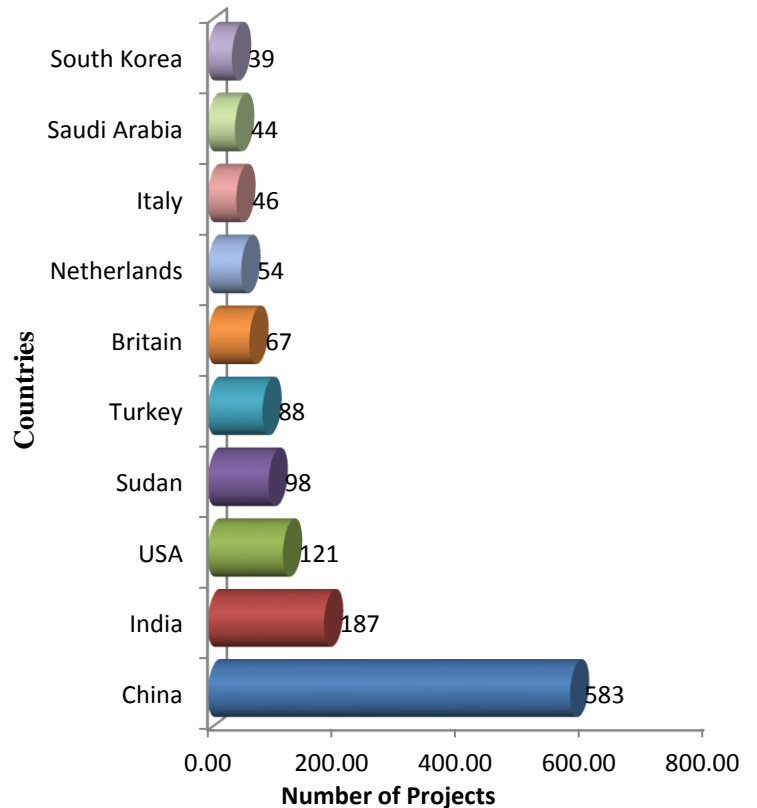
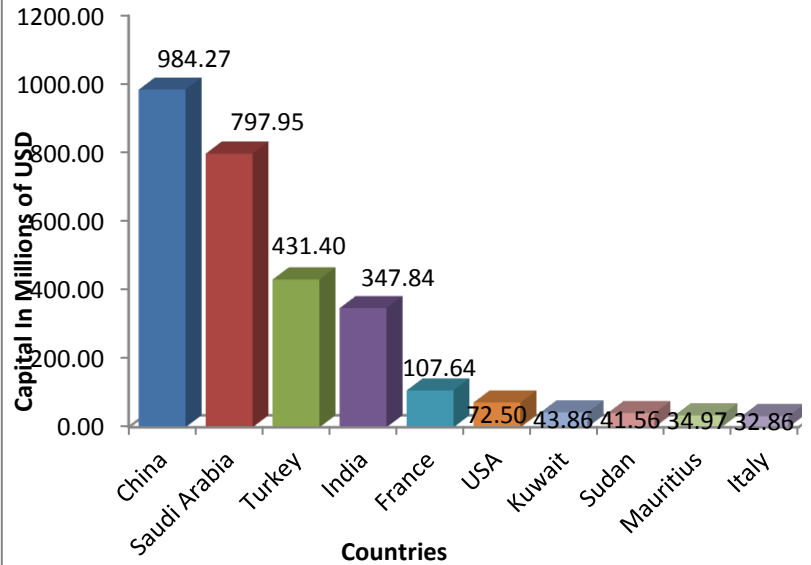

### Highlights of FDI's flow in Ethiopia from August 1992- June 2017

#### Top Ten FDI Flows by Capital and No Project

- The top ten FDIs registered an investment capital of USD 2.9 billion;
- The top ten projects licenced by the comission and became operational are 1327.
- China ranks first both by capital and No. of projects.
- From African countries Sudan investment registered quite significant number of projects.
- Saudi Arabia's investment registered a capital of USD 798 million and ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> by capital invested and 9<sup>th</sup> by No of project.
- From EU countries France ranks 5<sup>th</sup> by investing USD 108 million and Italy invested USD 33 million. Birtain incorporated in the top ten ranked by No. of projects but not by capital invested.
- This implies that some countries may have more projects but less capital and viseversa.



### FDI's flow by Sectors and Regions

- Manufacturing, real estate, Agriculture, construction, hotel, tour operation, health, education and mining sectors became operational. Out of the total number of operational investment projects manufacturing is still dominant i.e. 46 percent followed by real estate and machinery renting. 23 percent. Agriculture which constitutes 11 percent of FDI inflow is ranked at 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Most of FDI flows concentrated in Addis Ababa and surroundings with 1616 registered projects. Oromia region is next destination of FDI with operational project of 725.
- All of the total operational investment projects i.e. 2,717 invested about USD 5.5 billion and created job opportunities for about 280, 277 permanent and 304,592 casual workers.
